Council Connection

Recent Council Actions from July 1 Meeting

- Approved the application from Verizon Wireless to install a 75-foot monopole and a small equipment building within a leased area at Sitzer Park. This monopole will replace a current light pole and its design will match the existing tower at the park.
- Approved a resolution supporting an amendment to the Ramsey County's Rice Creek North Trail Master Plan. The changes include the extension of the trail from County Road I to County Road H and a trail extension to the south that will connect with the Highway 96 regional trail. Additional amenities include a canoe/kayak access point and potential cross country ski trails.
