Recent Council Actions from July 15 Meeting

- Approved the final plat, planned unit development amendment, and easement vacation at the SuperTarget located on 3800 Lexington Avenue.
- Held a Planned Unit Development Concept Stage Review for a proposed redevelopment of the Kozlak's Restaurant property located at 4785 Hodgson Road. The proposal calls for the removal of the restaurant and construction of a 3-story senior cooperative building based on the Applewood Pointe product developed by United Properties. Although no formal action is taken by the City at this stage of the review process, the Council heard comments from several Shoreview residents and provided feedback to the developer on the proposed redevelopment project.
