Recent Council actions from February 3 meeting

- Approved a comprehensive plan amendment and a planned unit development - development stage application to convert the former House of Dreams property, located at 4001 Rice Street, to Hummingbird Floral and Gifts.
- Approved a Wireless Telecommunications Facility Permit application and a ground lease for Verizon Wireless to locate a cell tower on the existing monopole at the City's Maintenance Center. The City will receive an annual lease payment beginning at \$14,800 and escalating at 5% per year during the 20 year lease term.
- Appointed Steve Solomonson as Chair of the Planning Commission.
