## Council Connection

Recent Council actions from October 6 meeting:

- **Minor Subdivision at 4525 Rice Street:** Approved a minor subdivision request that divides the property at 4525 Rice Street into two parcels for single-family residential development. This property has been proposed for development on several occasions. This subdivision would create two parcels with a single-family home on each parcel.
- **Live Streaming of Meetings and Events:** Approved a proposal from Granicus, Inc. for live and on-demand video streaming services. This will allow the City to stream its City Council and Planning Commission meetings live and archive them on the City's website for playback.
- **Appointments to Economic Development Commission:** Appointed Michael Tarvin and Kirk VanBlaircom to the Economic Development Commission.
