



City Council

Highlights from the July 13, 2015 City Council meeting include:

- The City Council authorized the issuance and sale of \$10,000,000 General Obligation improvement and utility revenue bonds. These bonds will be used to finance a number of street and utility improvements throughout the city, along with a major portion of the new Water Treatment Plant that is currently under construction.
- The City Council authorized an agreement with Braun Intertec in the amount of \$34,321 for special inspection and testing for the Water Treatment Plant (WTP). During construction of the WTP, special inspections and testing are required for soils located under and around the building, structural concrete and masonry and pavement.
