recycling fee and authorized the request of SCORE funding allocation. The 2016 budget includes a \$1.00 recycling fee increase that will be collected on the Ramsey County



property tax statements. SCORE grant monies are used in conjunction with City recycling fee revenues to fund the City's recycling program.

- Approved a small rate increase for Community Center memberships and daily passes as well as an increase for room rentals. The daily admission and membership rates were last increased in January 2015, and the banquet hall and meeting room rates were last increased in January 2014. These rates will go into effect in 2016. However, anything that has already been booked would not be subject to the rate increase.
