The City Council took the following actions at their April 4, 2016 meeting:

- Appointed Jean Kiehnbaum and Matthew Cisneros to the Parks and Recreation Commission for terms ending January 31, 2019.
- Approved a resolution revising city election precincts. This revision combines Precinct 1N and Precinct 2 and renumbers the precincts 1-6. This revision was necessary when the city was recently informed that they would no longer have the use of a facility previously used as a polling location.
- Approved an ordinance revising the Municipal Code regarding accessory structures and buildings. This amendment clarifies definitions as well as introduces a tiered system for accessory structure based on parcel size. The changes address concerns related to the health, safety and general welfare of the residents and public safety staff.
