## ***City Council***

The City Council took the following actions at their Sept. 6, 2016 meeting:

- Approved a request by Elevage Development group to redevelop 3527 Rice Street and incorporate the parcel into the mixed use development on the adjacent properties at: 157 County Road E, 185 County

- Adopted a resolution establishing the preliminary tax levy in the amount of \$11,085,632 and an HRA tax levy of \$105,000 for collection in 2017. The Council also set a public hearing date for December 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the 2017 budget.
- Approved a change order to the Gramsie Road Rehabilitation project in the amount of \$183,231.00 that would raise the low point of Gramsie Road that has been prone to flooding by 2 feet, which also includes raising the portion of trail adjacent to the road. It also includes the construction of a new trail on the south side of Gramsie Road to address the flooding of the current trail.
